

Policy Statement

Work Health and Safety

Seqwater ensures a safe, secure, resilient and reliable water supply for almost three million people across South East Queensland. We are also responsible for flood mitigation and catchment management, recreation facilities, and irrigation services to rural customers. We manage more than \$10 billion of water supply assets, with operations extending from the New South Wales border, to the base of the Toowoomba ranges and north to Gympie.

We are committed to the health and safety of all people in the workplace. Our goal is to operate without injuries, illnesses or incidents.



To demonstrate our commitment we will:

- ✓ create a positive work health and safety culture and provide positive behavioural programs
- ✓ provide information, training, instruction or supervision to enable employees to conduct activities in a safe manner
- ✓ create an environment of continual improvement where risks to health and safety are eliminated or, where it is not reasonably practicable to do so, the risk is minimised in accordance with the hierarchy of controls
- ✓ provide proactive leadership and promote the personal responsibility of every individual for their own work health and safety and the work health and safety of others
- ✓ consult, cooperate and coordinate with our employees, contractors and other stakeholders regarding work health and safety matters
- ✓ support actions aimed at increasing worker safety and wellbeing outside working hours.

All officers and workers have a responsibility to actively participate in the development of safe work practices and procedures.

We will comply with the work health and safety performance requirements set by relevant legislation. We will establish measureable objectives and targets to ensure continued improvement aimed at elimination of work-related injury and illness through our Work Health and Safety Management System certified to the Australian Standard (AS/NZS 4801:2001).

This policy applies to all of our employees and contractors and to any person or organisation that acts for or represents us.
