

DOGS ON LEASH

Hinze Dam



Hinze Dam is located in the Gold Coast hinterland, 15 kilometres south-west of Nerang. The lake provides the main drinking water supply for the Gold Coast region, as well as offering a range of recreational facilities.

Dogs at Hinze Dam

During 2014, Seqwater reviewed recreational facilities and opportunities at Hinze Dam. As a result of community feedback, dogs on leash will be welcome in designated areas at Hinze Dam from Monday, 1 December 2014.

Permitted areas

Dogs on leash may enter the following recreation areas at Hinze Dam:

- Picnic Parkland
- Pocket Park
- The pathway from Picnic Parkland to the upper car park.

Dogs and other domestic pets are not permitted at Waterside Park, the Visitor Centre and café, or on the dam wall.

Dogs and other pets must not be brought onto any of the trails around the lake.





Play it safe

For public safety, dog owners must control their pets. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. You may lead a maximum of two dogs at a time.

The parks are community facilities to be enjoyed by everyone. Some visitors may be uncomfortable or frightened around dogs. Please be considerate of others who are enjoying the park area with you.

For the safety of those around you, dogs are not permitted to enter the playground area. Play it safe and everyone will have a great day.

Water quality and the environment

Hinze Dam is one of the main drinking water sources for the Gold Coast region. Please protect our drinking water supply and:

- leave the facilities as you found them. Do not cause damage to any property, fauna or flora
- place litter in the bins provided
- control your dog, and do not let them disturb the wildlife that lives in the area.

Dogs are prohibited from all foreshore areas and boat ramps and are not permitted to enter the lake at any time.

Consider others

When you visit, please have the necessary equipment with you to pick up and dispose of your dog's droppings in a sanitary way. Thank you for placing all litter in the bins provided.

Plan your visit

The recreation areas at Hinze Dam are open from 6.00am to 6.00pm, seven days a week. A variety of recreation activities are on offer – to view the list of permitted activities at Hinze and how to play it safe, visit seqwater.com.au.
