Ewen Maddock Dam:

Establish wash down facilities for paddle craft and swimmers	Implemented June 2014	Yes
Improve trail signage and mapping	Directional totems installed. Mapping and signage being developed and a four week trial to take place over April 2017. Installation of new permanent signage on hold until after the trial is complete and the toilet is installed at Ornamental Wetlands in mid-2017.	In progress
Upgrade Gympie Street North entry point to the trail network	Pedestrian access has been improved and entry fences replaced. Council has completed works	Yes
Improve paddle craft access	Path to water from car park upgraded in February 2014	Yes
Improve car parking facilities	Car park improved and trailer parking added in February 2014	Yes

The following outcomes have been achieved:

- 1) The phase out of the boating permit scheme, which will conclude on 31 July 2017. From 1 August 2017, the scheme will discontinue in its entirety and no boating permits will be sold from this date.
- 2) Change to opening hours to reflect seasonal daylight hours. The new opening hours are 5:30am to 6:30pm from 1 September through to 30 April; and 6:00am to 5:30pm from 1 May through to 31 August.
