

These local transfer conditions are to be read in conjunction with the conditions as set out on the Seasonal Water Assignment (Temporary Transfer) Application Form and relevant to the applicable scheme where indicated.

All Schemes - Loss Adjustments

Under normal conditions there are no loss adjustments. Segwater will advise applicants if a

loss adjustment will be required for example, in extremely dry conditions where high losses may occur with the transfer of the water.

All schemes - Transfer Adjustment Fee

A Transfer Adjustment Fee, equal to the value of Seqwater's applied irrigation subsidised price or discount to full commercial pricing, may be payable where water is transferred from a regulated irrigation pricing use to a non-irrigation use. It is the responsibility of the parties to any such transfer to contact Seqwater to ascertain this fee in advance of settlement.

Cedar Pocket Water Supply Scheme – Trading Caps

The maximum volume the seller may transfer cannot exceed the volume available on the seller's water account at the time of application.

A water allocation holder may apply for a seasonal water assignment where the proposed seasonal assignment would not result in a use of water allocations outside the cap limitations as per Attachment 4 Part 2 Table 4 of the Mary Basin ROP and shown below.

Central Brisbane River Water Supply Scheme – Trading Caps

A water allocation holder may apply for a seasonal water assignment where the proposed seasonal assignment would not result in the total water use in a water year for each zone to exceed the maximum allowable water use volumes as per table 6 of the Central Brisbane River WSS Operations Manual and shown below.
