Your opportunity

As the Trainee Network Operations, you will develop competencies to be able to assist in carrying out activities associated with operating the bulk drinking water supply network to effectively meet water delivery requirements, regulatory standards, and operational efficiencies.

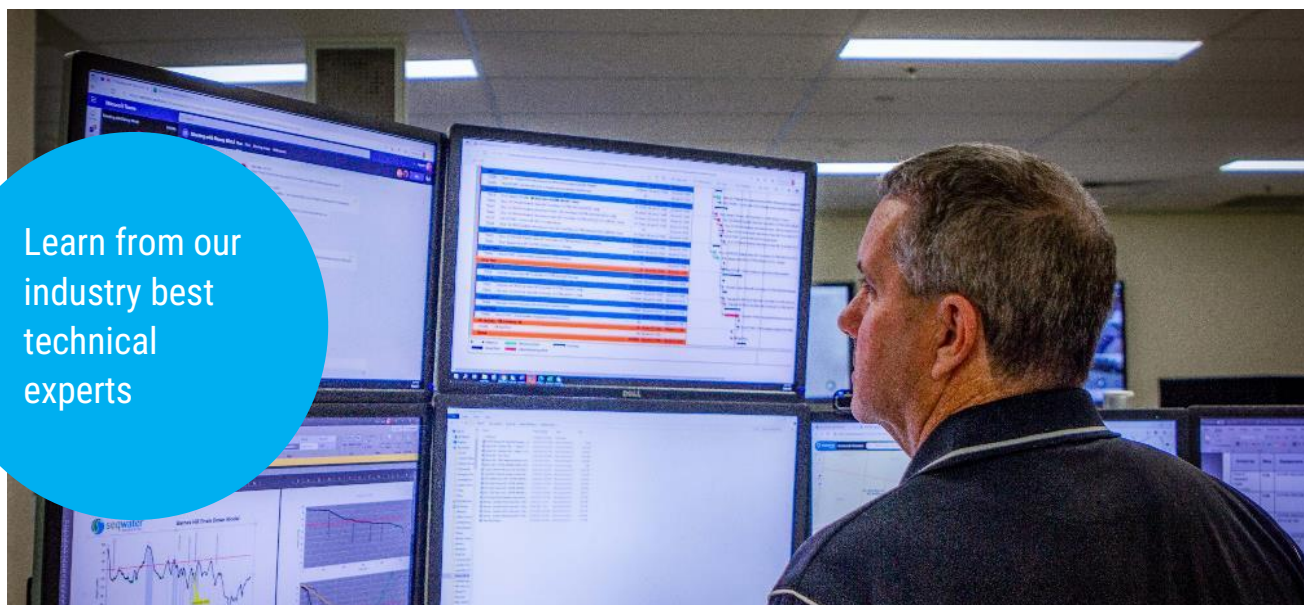
You will work with a great team of experienced operators to deliver a safe, sustainable and valued drinking water supply to the South East Queensland community.

You will support and assist with optimising supply systems to ensure continuity of water supply; and provide operational input and support to allow effective and efficient implementation of continuous improvements in the operation of the bulk water supply system.

This position will require the successful applicant to participate in a set roster pattern, which may include weekend and public holiday work. In addition to this, once you have reached a suitable level of competency, you may be required to participate in an on-call roster and respond to call-outs at any time outside of normal working hours.

Appointment to this role is subject to the provision of a pre-employment medical and a national police check. Please note that people with criminal records are not automatically deemed ineligible. Each application will be considered on its merits.

Key responsibilities

No two days are the same as a Trainee Network Operations. While undertaking your traineeship, you will work toward developing your knowledge and understanding of all aspects and duties of a Supply System Operator.

As a Trainee Network Operations, you will work under supervision to learn and develop your skills across a broad range of network operations and activities. These include monitoring water supply levels and water quality across the network, escalating issues or anomalies where appropriate and undertaking fault finding and analysis of network defects and events.

Use your critical thinking skills to assist with defect reviews, analysis and collation of commissioning data, and identifying improvements to systems and procedures to maintain and improve performance. You will also assist with monitoring and controlling the supply of water across a large geographic region, under supervision, using the SCADA system within the Supply Network Control Centre.

While undertaking your traineeship, you will be required to meet ongoing learning requirements of the training program; complete required modules within a reasonable timeframe; and actively participate in operational activities that contribute to your overall learning experiences. You will also become familiar with operating management systems and gain knowledge of word processor and spreadsheet programs.

About you

You will show a strong sense of curiosity and a willingness to learn. You will be eager to undertake a Certificate III in Water Industry Operations (Networks); confined space training; and any additional training required to carry out the duties of an Network Operator.

You will be committed to learning continuously throughout your traineeship to develop the understanding, knowledge and skills that an operator needs to succeed in their role.

Driving between and around our sites is common in this role, so it is important that you possess a current C class driver's license for a manual vehicle.

Ideally you will also have:

- Basic computer skills and working knowledge of Microsoft Office
- Good English, Science and Math skills and an ability to problem solve
- An ability to use initiative and actively / positively contribute to a team environment
- Sound interpersonal skills, both verbal and written, and sound personal time management.
