

Irrigation Pricing Rebate Scheme

Applications are now open for the 15% discount on irrigation prices

The Queensland Government is continuing the 15% discount on irrigation prices for eligible customers for two more years (2025–26 and 2026–27).

You must pay your bill from Seqwater or Sunwater (including Burnett Water) first. After that, you can apply to the Queensland Rural and Industry Development Authority (QRIDA) to get the discount as a rebate.

Eligibility for the rebate

The eligibility requirements include that:

- › you, or at least one owner of your business, provide labour to your business
- › your business, or at least one owner of your business, declares primary production income for tax purposes
- › your business irrigates from time to time
- › your business is not wholly or partly operated or owned by:
 - a public company
 - a managed investment scheme
 - a foreign company
 - a superannuation entity other than a self-managed superannuation fund.

How to apply for the rebate

Apply online via the QRIDA portal or submit a paper form.

Call QRIDA on 1800 623 946 (toll free) to receive the application form by post.

Application closing date

You have until 31 December 2027 to apply. You can apply with each bill or consolidate your bills in one application at any time.
