

Community Update

Seqwater is investigating long-term solutions to improve water supply reliability during dry conditions and support the needs of Canungra's growing community. In this update you'll find the latest project information, details about upcoming investigations and opportunities to meet the project team and learn more about the project.

Project Overview

Canungra relies on water sourced from Canungra Creek and is not connected to the SEQ Water Grid. This means the town's water supply can be affected when creek flows are low due to changing rainfall patterns, upstream water use and growing demand.

Planning now helps ensure the community has reliable water supply into the future as demand grows and climate conditions become less predictable. We're investigating options for the Canungra Water Supply Scheme Upgrade, including off-stream water storage, to improve water security during dry periods, provide greater long-term reliability and support future community growth.

An off-stream water storage facility would allow water to be captured from Canungra Creek during periods of higher flow and stored for use when flows are lower.

Unlike a traditional dam or weir, off-stream storages are not typically constructed on a waterway. Instead, they are filled by transferring water from a local source, such as Canungra Creek, when conditions are suitable.

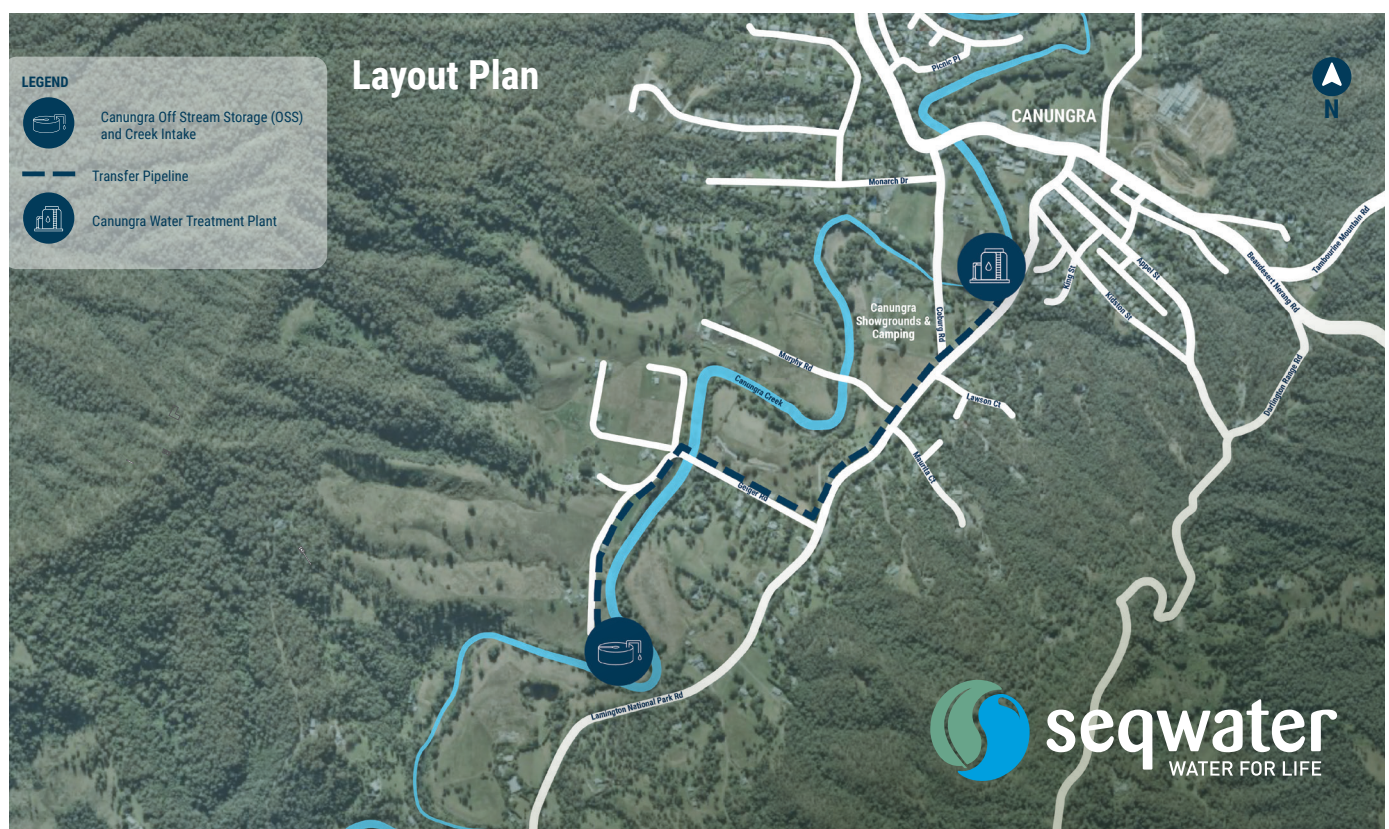
This option is being developed to provide greater flexibility in how water is managed locally, helping support a more reliable and resilient supply for the Canungra community into the future.

Project Update

We've taken an important step in planning for Canungra's future water needs, securing land that will help us provide long-term water security options for the community.

The purchase of approximately 50 hectares south of Canungra provides a defined project footprint and enables the next stage of planning. This includes environmental and technical investigations, site studies, and the development of a concept design for the proposed off-stream storage facility and pipeline alignment.

We expect to share a concept design from late 2026.

We are currently in the planning and approvals phase with the Preliminary Business Case underway and expected to be completed by late 2026. The Detailed Business Case and final design are planned for completion by late 2027. Subject to investment approvals, construction could begin by late 2028.
