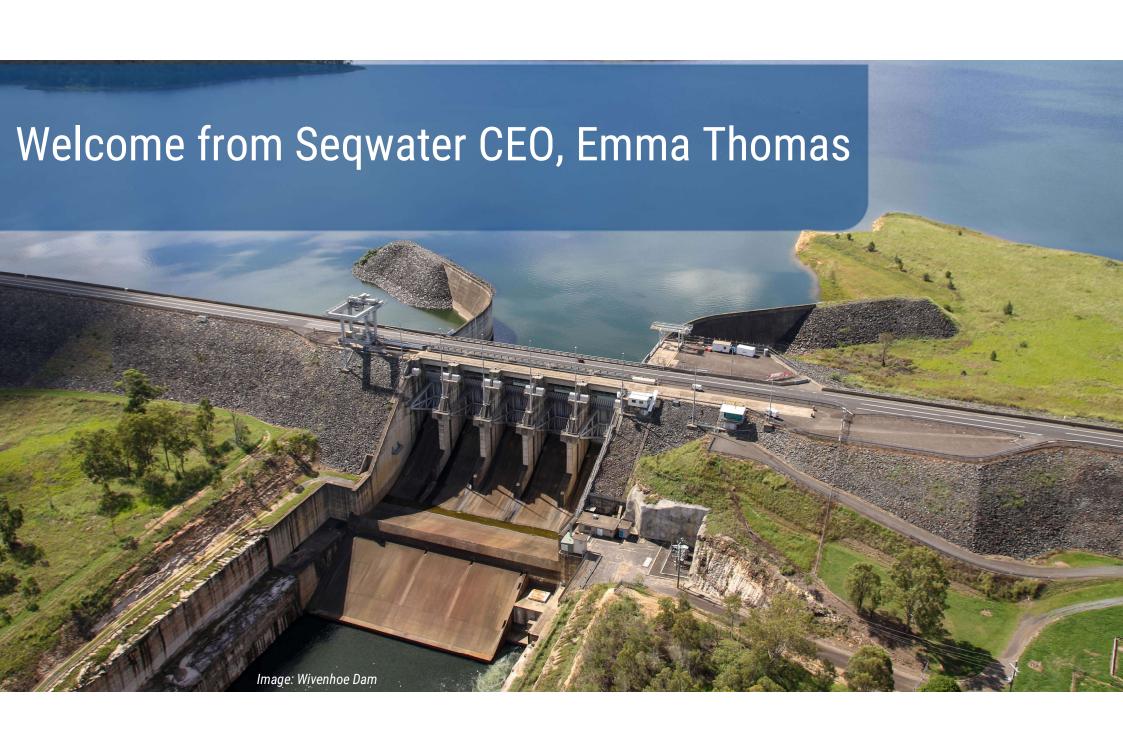

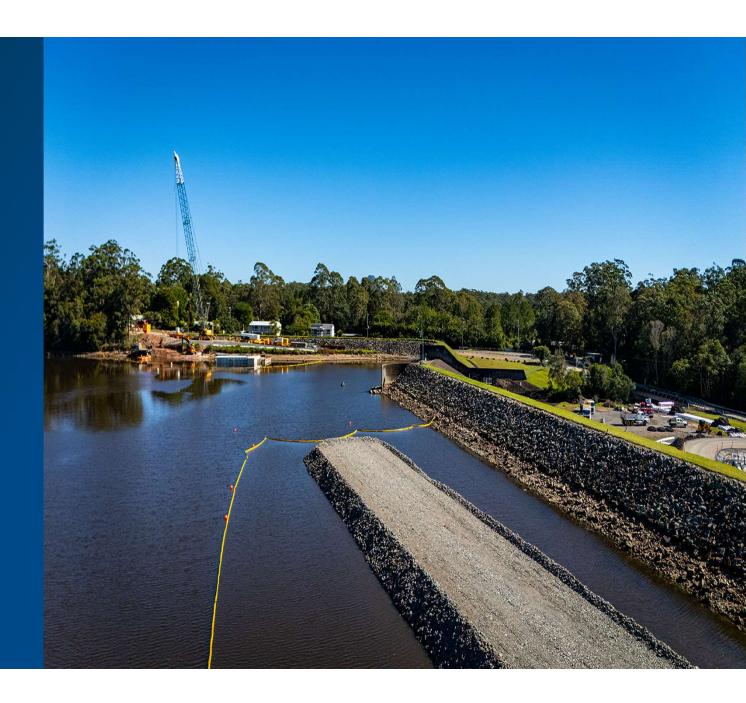


Image: Lake Macdonald Dam construction currently underway

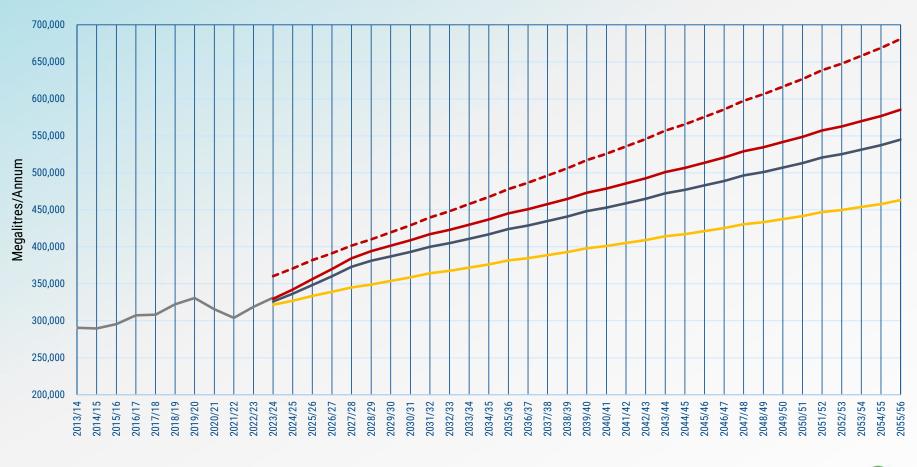

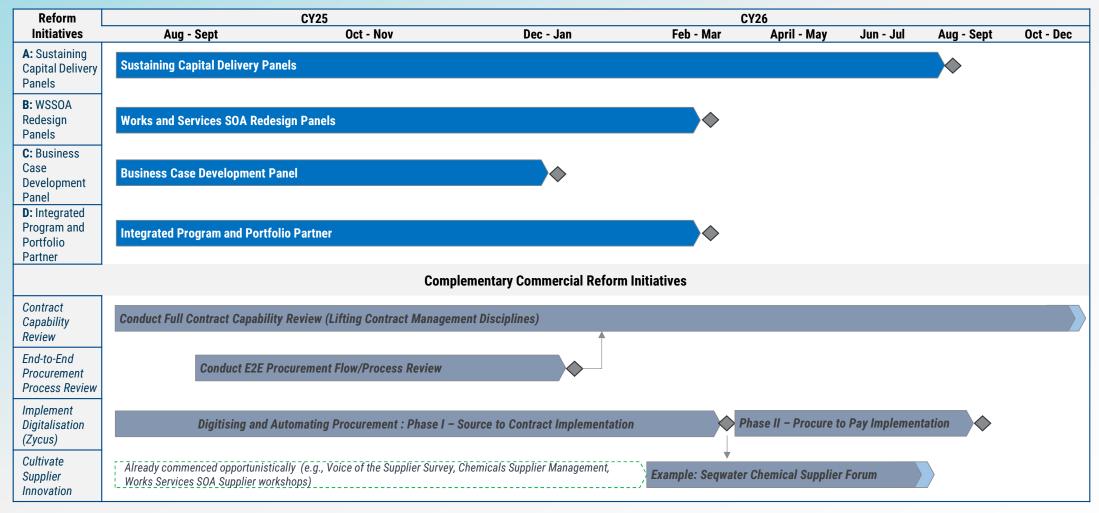
