

# Policy Statement

## Asset Management

Seqwater delivers a safe, secure and cost-effective water supply for over 3 million people across South East Queensland. We provide irrigation water to 1,200 rural customers in seven water supply schemes, as well as essential flood mitigation services, catchment flood mitigation services, catchment management and recreation facilities.

On behalf of our communities we manage and maintain water supply assets, including dams, weirs, conventional water treatment plants, reservoirs, pumps and pipelines, as well as climate resilient water sources such as the Gold Coast Desalination Plant and the Western Corridor Recycled Water Scheme.

Our operations extend from the New South Wales border to the base of the Toowoomba ranges and north to Gympie.

**We are committed to efficient and proactive management of our assets to provide safe, affordable and reliable water and catchment services for the long-term benefit of communities in South East Queensland.**

### To demonstrate our commitment we will:
