

Policy Statement

Modern Slavery

Seqwater delivers a safe, secure, and cost-effective water supply for over 3 million people across South East Queensland. We provide irrigation water to 1,200 rural customers in seven water supply schemes, as well as essential flood mitigation services, catchment management and recreation facilities.

On behalf of our communities, we manage and maintain water supply assets, including dams, weirs, conventional water treatment plants, reservoirs, pumps and pipelines, as well as climate resilient water sources, such as the Gold Coast Desalination Plant and the Western Corridor Recycled Water Scheme.

Our operations extend from the New South Wales border to the base of the Toowoomba ranges and north to Gympie

We are committed to minimising the risk of modern slavery in our supply chain and internal operations.

Our goal is to build an ethical supply chain by taking an active role in addressing potential modern slavery risks associated with our organisation.

To demonstrate our commitment we will:

- ✓ act with integrity in all of our business operations and align our commitment to modern slavery with our values of integrity, respect, care and courage
- ✓ engage talent using robust and defensible recruitment practices
- ✓ consider how our supply chain could potentially be linked to modern slavery
- ✓ take an active role in addressing potential modern slavery risks associated with our organisation
- ✓ work with our suppliers to increase our understanding of our supply chain and support informed decision making within procurement
- ✓ make a conscious effort to source suppliers based within Australia
- ✓ progressively develop a more comprehensive understanding of our supply chain to provide improved visibility as to geographic location and nature of goods and services source to inform our supply chain risk assessments
- ✓ identify and respond to issues of compliance and concern
- ✓ review our actions on a regular basis to continually improve

We will comply with our obligations under the *Modern Slavery Act 2018* (Cth), monitor our actions, and seek to continually improve our understanding of our supply chain and associated risks.

Seqwater is committed to being respected as a leading water authority and achieving our vision - Water For Life.

This policy applies to all of our employees and contractors and to any person or organisation that acts for or represents us.
