East Bank Flood Resilience Program Civil and Enabling Works

The Mount Crosby Water Treatment Plants are a critical part of the SEQ Water Grid and supply about 50 percent of South East Queensland’s drinking water including Brisbane, Ipswich and Logan. The East Bank Flood Resilience Program (the Program) involves a number of improvements to reduce asset and flood risks to essential bulk water infrastructure at the historical Mount Crosby East Bank Precinct.

Seqwater has awarded the construction contract for the program’s Civil and Enabling Works (the works) to Mcllwain Civil Engineering Pty Ltd.

The works involve earthworks, the construction of retaining walls, a substation pad and a sealed road to the substation. The Eastern Access Road will be upgraded including conduit installation and reconfiguring the six-way intersection. Once complete, Energex will construct a new substation.

What does the work involve?

- The works will commence from March 2022 and are expected to be complete by the end of the year.
- Standard working hours are Monday to Friday between 6:30am and 6:30pm. Saturdays 7:00am to 2:00pm for critical works if required.
- The works will involve the use of heavy plant and equipment which will be accessing site via Stumers Road. There may be an increase in noise, dust and traffic and we will reduce these impacts where possible.
- Vegetation removal will be minimised and will be in compliance with the approved Development Application. All vegetation removal work will be supervised by an arborist and spotter-catcher.
- The work area will be fenced off during the construction period, so please follow the instructions of our staff and signage.

Will the Kindergarten remain open?

Yes. The adjacent C & K Community Kindergarten will continue to operate during the construction period and the project team will work closely with C & K to minimise impacts and ensure public safety.
