

# Lake Macdonald Dam Improvement Project

## FACT SHEET - Traffic Management

The Lake Macdonald Dam Improvement Project is part of Seqwater's Dam Improvement Program. The project has commenced main construction works, which includes building a temporary upstream cofferdam, a new spillway and fixing the existing embankments. Seqwater is proud to partner with John Holland as the major construction contractor to this essential project. These improvements will reduce risks from extreme weather, meet regulations, and ensure reliable water supply for the Sunshine Coast region.

### School Zones

The management of heavy vehicle movements through school zones and the safety of the local community is critical to the project team.

Heavy vehicle movements will be minimised throughout construction during school pick up/drop off to six, two-way movements between 7.20am to 8.45am and 2.30pm to 3.45pm.

Advanced notification will be provided to stakeholders if there are any changes to heavy vehicle movements during school pick up/drop off times throughout the main construction period.

Seqwater and John Holland are committed to:

- The safety of motorists, pedestrians, local residents, cyclists and construction workers
- Promoting the safe behaviour of staff and contractors in your area
- Ensuring the reliable flow of traffic during construction
- Maintaining access to properties and minimising impacts where possible.

The community can contribute to safe road practices by:

- Paying attention to road signs near construction sites
- Planning your trip and allowing extra travel time
- Keeping an eye out for road workers
- Remaining calm and patient
- Being aware of changed traffic conditions
- Maintaining a safe distance between your vehicle and other vehicles on the road.

Speed limits and road signs are enforceable throughout construction areas.

### Traffic Management

During construction, the local community and stakeholders may see an increase in construction traffic, including heavy vehicles in and around Lake Macdonald.

A Traffic Management Plan has been developed to ensure the safety of residents, road users and construction workers during the project.

Temporary traffic changes will occur and may include speed limit reductions, lane closures, temporary traffic signals, traffic controllers in place and temporary signage. Fencing and barriers will also be installed to delineate safe work areas from public spaces.

Heavy vehicles are approved by the Office of the Coordinator-General to use Elm Street and Lake Macdonald Drive. More information on heavy vehicles available overleaf.

Advanced notifications will be provided to the community and stakeholders prior to any major traffic changes or diversions.

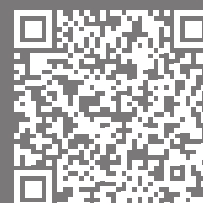
