Traffic Management

Temporary traffic changes will occur and may include speed limit reductions, lane closures, temporary traffic signals, traffic controllers in place and temporary signage.

Fencing and barriers will also be installed to delineate safe work areas from public spaces.

Advanced notifications will be provided to the community and stakeholders prior to any major traffic changes or diversions.
